# When We Grow Indifferent Toward The Church

- *You can be indifferent toward the gospel message.*
- *You can be indifferent toward the work of the church.*
- *You can be indifferent by “forsaking the assembly”  
(Hebrews 10:25).*

# When We Lose Interest in Bible Study

- The Bible is an example of God's love: *"Your word is a lamp to my feet, a light to my path"* (Ps. 119:105).
- We cannot grow in *"grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior"* (2 Pet. 3:18) without the Word.
- *"Daily resistance comes from daily reliance on the Word."*

# When We Lose Interest in Prayer

- *Failing to pray is saying, “I do not need God.”*
- *“Lord, teach us to pray” (Luke 11:1).*
- *If the Lord needed to pray, how much more we need to “pray without ceasing” (1 Thess. 5:17).*

# When We Are More Interested in the Material Than the Spiritual

- *“Love not the world . . .” (1 John 2:15).*
- *Anything that dominates our lives more than our relationship with God will cost us our salvation.*
- *“Nothing in this world is worth missing Heaven.”*

# What Must We Do?

- *We must restore our focus (Colossians 3:2).*
- *We must renew our priorities (Matthew 6:33).*
- *We must return to our first love (Rev. 2:4).*
