The Way of the Cross Leads Home

"Being always of good courage, and knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord – we prefer rather to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord"

(2 Corinthians 5:6, 8).

Surrender

- "If any man wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself..." (Luke 9:23a).
 - We are not good at self-denial, including American saints who are caught in a culture of acquiring whatever we want.
 - We will go to great lengths, often at great harm to ourselves and others, to achieve what we believe we need or deserve.
 - Yet, the voice of Jesus says, "If you wish to come after Me . . . "; three examples of men who said "No" (Luke 9:57-62).

Suffer

- "... and take up his cross daily ..." (23b).
 - Sometimes we suffer innocently (John 9:1-3).
 - Sometimes we suffer as a consequence of our sins: "I will show him how much he must suffer for My name's sake" (Acts 9:16).
 - Sometimes we suffer because we are determined to stand firm in our faithful service and commitment to Jesus: "I suffer and am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed" (2 Timothy 1:12).

Sacrifice

• "... and follow Me" (23c).

- Not, "How much can I get, but how much can I give?"
- Not, "What is the safe thing, but what is the right thing to do?"
- Not, "What is the least I can do for the Lord and people, but what is the most I can do in the time I have left?"

Secure

God will be with us and supply our needs.

Jesus will protect and intercede for us.

The Spirit will abide with us.

The love of God will keep us.

All things will work to our ultimate good.
