# The Commission to Preach Given

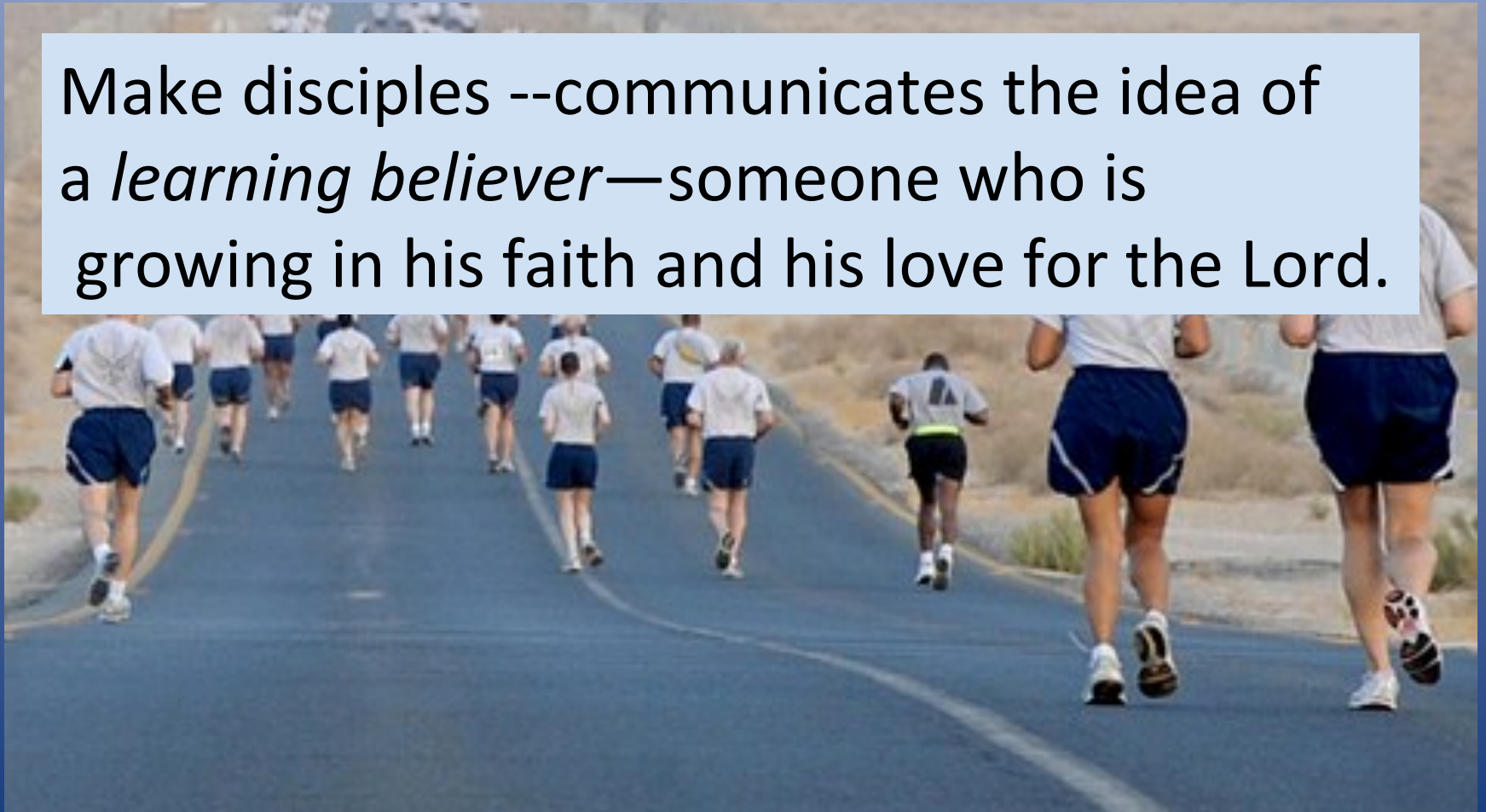
“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations,...” (Matthew 28:19)

# Preaching – A Continuation of the Conversion Process

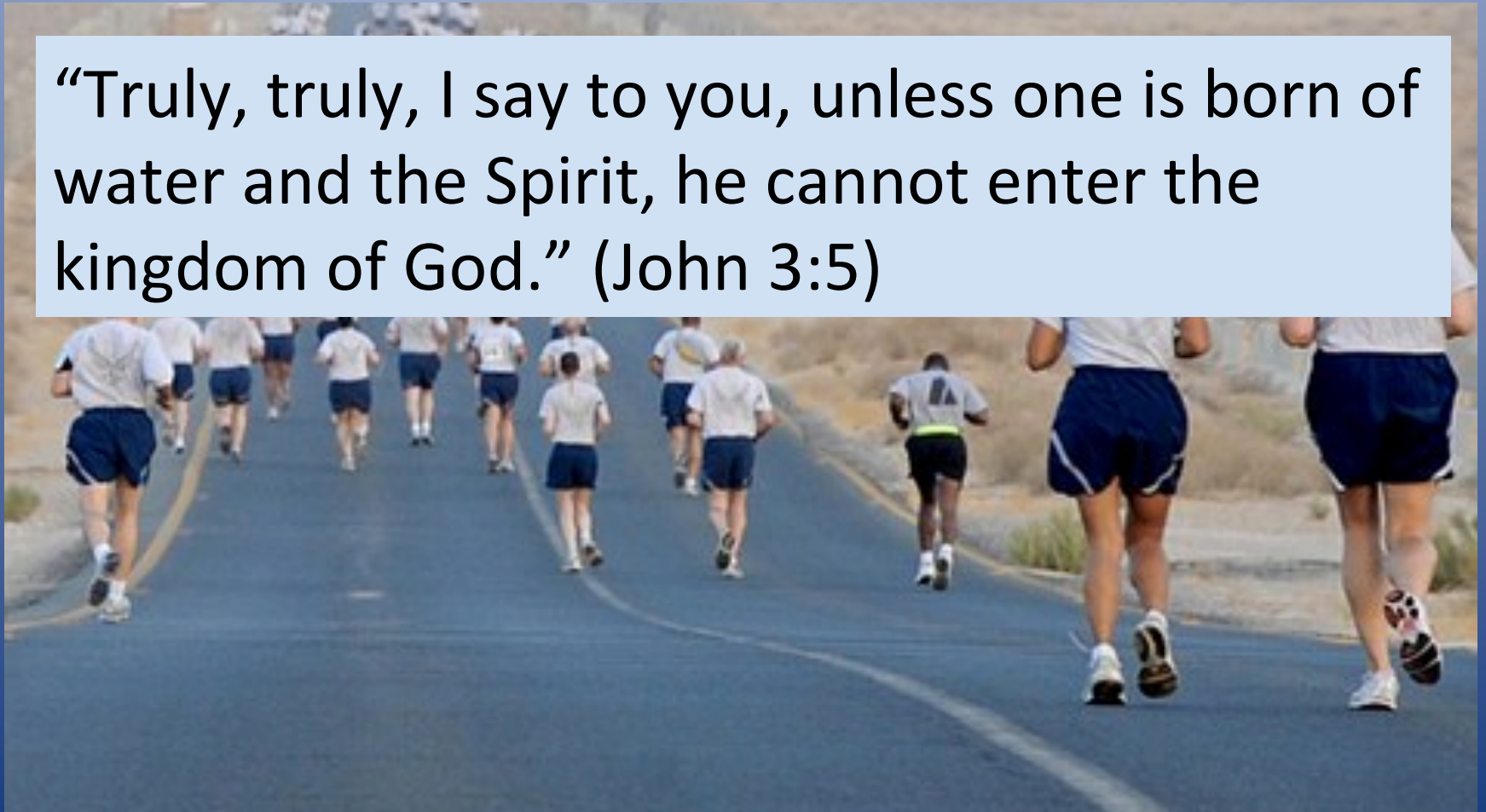
“So I am eager to preach the gospel to you also who are in Rome.” (Romans 1:15)
