- Wasted journey: one without purpose or destination.
- Wise living: live with purpose
 - Jesus had purpose: His Father's business (Matt. 1:21; Luke 2:49)
 - You must live with purpose: keeps you focused on the goal





Isaiah 2:1-4

- Wasted journey: one without purpose or destination.
- Wise living: live with purpose
 - Christians live with purpose; focused on a goal, Philippians 3:13-14
 - Focus on the goal keeps us Faithful as we go, Acts 20:24
 - Christians: called for God's purpose, Acts 9:15; Romans 8:28
