• You can be indifferent toward the gospel message.

• You can be indifferent toward the work of the church.

• You can be indifferent by "forsaking the assembly" (Hebrews 10:25).

When We Lose Interest in Bible Study

• The Bible is an example of God's love: "Your word is a lamp to my feet, a light to my path" (Ps. 119:105).

• We cannot grow in "grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior" (2 Pet. 3:18) without the Word.

• "Daily resistance comes from daily reliance on the Word."

When We Lose Interest in Prayer

• Failing to pray is saying, "I do not need God."

• "Lord, teach us to pray" (Luke 11:1).

• If the Lord needed to pray, how much more we need to "pray without ceasing" (1 Thess. 5:17).
