

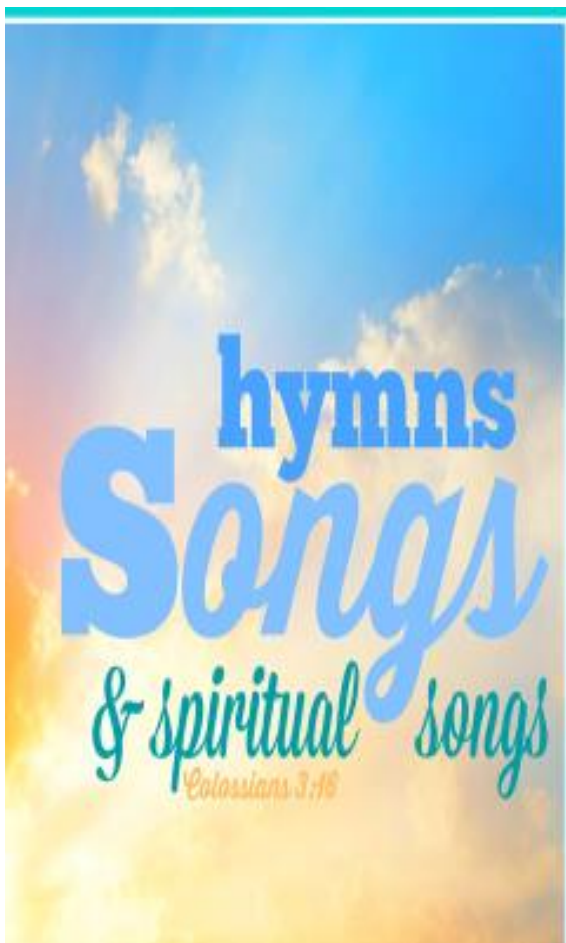

Focused On Compassion

It is one of my favorite words, and one of the most beautiful in the English language, *compassion*, our congregational theme for the beautiful, and busy, month of June. To be compassionate is much more than being heart-touched by the needs of someone; it also means you stop and help them relieve their need to the best of your ability. The Lord brought the Good Samaritan to life just to illustrate this very point: *"when he saw him, he felt compassion, and came to him and bandaged up his wounds"* (Luke 10:33-34).

Jesus did more than just tell stories about compassion, He *defines* compassion! Think of the man afflicted with leprosy who the Lord *touch*ed and he was immediately healed (Matthew 8:3), and the Roman centurion who begged the Lord to *"just say the word, and my servant will be healed"* (8:8), and he was. Remember the daughter of Jairus, a young girl who had died and her father implored the Lord to *"lay Your hand upon her, and she will live"* (9:18). He did, and she did. Or the bewildered lady with a twelve-year hemorrhage who said, *"If I only touch His garment, I will get well"* (9:21). She did and was made whole.

Obviously, we cannot miraculously heal as could the Lord, but we can do far more than what we imagine. It is one thing to feel sorry for the lost, but another to seek, find, and bring them to the Lord. It is one thing to see someone in misery, and another to enter their miserable situation and help them. It is one thing to hear of a person in crisis, but another to rush to them and do instinctively what you know to do. It is one thing to tell someone, "I will pray for you," and another to fall to your knees before the Father in their behalf. It is one thing to have the good intention of visiting someone sick, grieving, or dying, and another to make that visit and encourage them. It is both the feeling and the doing that is *compassion!*

Our Henderson family has so many opportunities to show the Lord's love and compassion every single day. Let's continue to help in all the ways open to us, remembering that while we help the person, we are honoring our Lord in *doing* His work.
