## The Love God Hates

"Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him" (1 John 2:15).

#### Because of What the World Is

• "World" is used in three ways in the New Testament.

• John refers to *Satan's system* in opposing the Lord's church and work.

• "If the world hates you, you know that it hated Me before it hated you" (John 15:18).

#### Because of What the World Does

• "If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him" (1 John 2:15).

• "The world is passing away, and also its lusts; but the one who does the will of God lives forever" (17).

• Here is Satan's attack: "the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eye, and the boastful pride of life" (16).

#### Because of What Christians Are

- John refers to three family terms to describe us:
  - "Little children" (12), who are babes in Christ.
  - "Young men" (13), those growing and maturing in the faith.
  - "Fathers" (14), the mature in faith, who know God and the dangers of the world, the full grown person of faith.

 Here is the Christian family: the growing, maturing child of God to whom the world does not appeal!

### Because of Where the World is Going

• "The world is passing away" (17a)!

 When this world is gone, the faithful child of God will be alive in the presence of God throughout eternity.

• "But the one who does the will of God lives forever" (17b).
