## REASONS TO REJOICE!

"Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice!" (Philippians 4:4)

## How To Greet Every Predicament (1-4)

- Can we really rejoice "always?"
- For Paul, the key is "in the Lord":
  - "Stand fast in the Lord" (1).
  - "Be of the same mind in the Lord" (2).
  - "Rejoice in the Lord" (4).
- Yet, we still ask, how?

## How To Treat Every Person (5)

- If not predicaments, it's people!
- "Let your moderation be known to all."
- This means "forbearing spirit," "sweet reasonableness," "patient understanding."
- Paul viewed the Philippians as his "joy and crown."

## How To Meet Every Problem (6-7)

- "Be careful (anxious) for nothing."
- This does not mean being "careless"; rather:
  - <u>Prayer</u>, reverence for God, our Father
  - Supplication, revealing our deepest needs and desires
  - Thanksgiving, remembering the constant goodness of God
- We must do everything we can, then leave the rest to the trusting hands of Almighty God.

If we follow Paul's inspired model for dealing with predicaments, people, and problems, we are assured of this superb promise:

"And the peace of God, which passes all understanding, shall keep your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus" (7).
