Reasons Not to Lose Heart

"Therefore" (vs. 7-15)

- The glory of God's power and of His Son (7, 10-11)
- The strengthening of the Lord's church (12, 15)
- The sustaining presence of God (8-9)
- Our own resurrection from the dead (14)

More Reasons Not to Lose Heart "For" (vs. 17-18)

Our present affliction is momentary (17a).

Our present affliction is light (17a).

Our affliction produces an eternal weight of glory (17b).

We see the unseen, eternal glory to come (18).

How Should We Respond?

• We should be **confident** of our salvation.

We should be strong while enduring pain.

We should be at peace with God and each other.

We should rejoice in our hope of eternal life.
