"Leaving God behind"

Galatians 1:6-9.

A Formula For Spiritual Disaster

- Galatians 1:6-7 "I marvel that you are turning away so soon from Him who called you in the grace of Christ, to a different gospel, 7 which is not another; but there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ."
- Galatians 5:4 "You have become estranged from Christ, you who attempt to be justified by law; you have fallen from grace."

Desertion of God

- Galatians 1:6 "I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting the one who called you to live in the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel." (NIV)
- Galatians 3:1 "O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you that you should not obey the truth,"
- They had deserted God by deserting his gospel.

Distortion of the Gospel

- Galatians 1:7 "there are some who trouble you and want to pervert (distort) the gospel of Christ."
- Galatians 5:2 "Indeed I, Paul, say to you that if you become circumcised, Christ will profit you nothing."

Distortion of the Gospel

- Why would they distort the gospel?
 - Galatians 2:4 To bring others into bondage (power).
 - Galatians 4:17 They do it to cause others to seek them (ego).
 - Galatians 6:12 "to make a good showing for themselves in the flesh
 - Galatians 6:12 To avoid rejection/persecution from the Jews for the sake of the cross of Christ.

Disregard For The Truth

- The cause of the Galatians" confusion/desertion.
- Galatians 1:8 "But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed."
- <u>II Corinthians 11:13-14</u> "For such *are* false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into apostles of Christ. **14** And no wonder! For Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light.

Disregard of the Danger

- Galatians 1:9 "As we have said before, so now I say again, if anyone preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received, <u>let him be</u> accursed."
- Acts 20:29-30 "For I know this, that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock. 30 Also from among yourselves men will rise up, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after themselves."

Decision to Honor God/Gospel

- Romans 2:4 "Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance?"
- <u>II Timothy 2:25</u> "in humility correcting those who are in opposition, if God perhaps will grant them repentance, so that they may know the truth,"
