## Man's Greatest Problem

- > THE POWER
  - The gospel is our focus
    - It is the power of God to salvation, Romans 1:16
    - The centrality of the Word in total is the gospel in specific, 1 Peter 1:22-25

## Man's Greatest Problem

- > THE POWER
  - The gospel emphasis
    - the *cross*1 Corinthians 1:17-18, 22-24; 2:1-2
    - The cross takes men to the "house of sorrow" Ecclesiastes 7:2-4; 2 Corinthians 7:8-10; Acts 2:36



## Man's Greatest Problem

- > THE PASSION
  - There must be deep concern for the draped chairs
    - **Romans 10:1-3**; **Ephesians 3:8-10**;
  - 1 Timothy 1:12-17The must be a great passion for God's purpose.
    - John 4:34-38; Matthew 28:18-20



## Man's Greatest Problem

#### > THE PASSION

- There must be willingness to walk on the water with Jesus in spite of our fears when it comes to seeking the seekers who are seeking, Matthew 14:22-33
- There must a determination to learn what and how to do and then do what you have learned, James 1:22-25; John 17:6-19

<sup>5</sup>Who then is Paul, and who is Apollos, but ministers through whom you believed, as the Lord gave to each one? <sup>6</sup>I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase. <sup>7</sup>So then neither he who plants is anything, nor he who waters, but God who gives the increase. <sup>8</sup>Now he who plants and he who waters are one, and each one will receive his own reward according to his own labor. <sup>9</sup>For we are God's fellow workers... 1 Corinthians 3:5-9a
