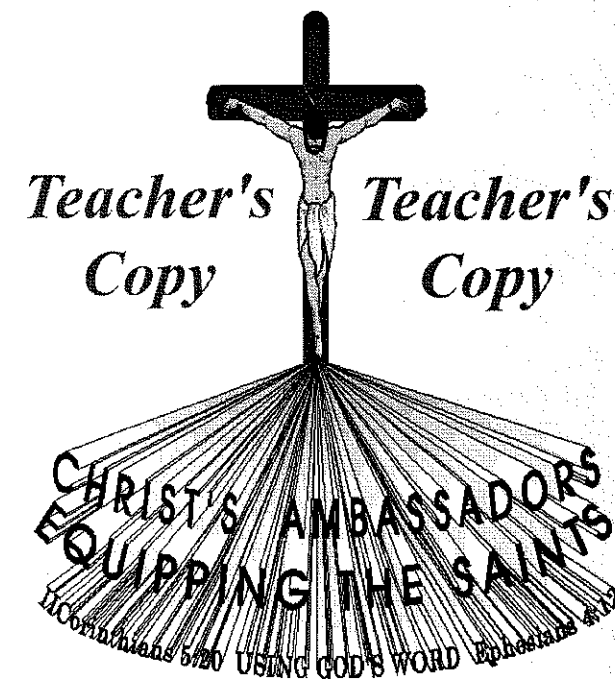

16. REVIEW AND SUMMARY

- a. The New Testament PATTERN concerning SALVATION includes the following:
 - 1. Belief in Jesus, the Son of God.
 - 2. Repentance of sin.
 - 3. Confession of Jesus before men.
 - 4. Baptism by immersion in water for the remission of sins.
 - 5. Walking in the light.
- b. The New Testament PATTERN concerning THE CHURCH includes the following:
 - 1. Jesus is the Head and Savior of only one church.
 - 2. No one can join the church of Christ, but is added by the Lord when properly baptized.
 - 3. Bishops (elders) in the one church must be married men with children.
 - 4. Men, not women, are to take the lead in public prayer and teaching.
 - 5. Religious titles such as "Father" or "Reverend" are condemned by Jesus.
- c. The New Testament PATTERN concerning WORSHIP includes the following:
 - 1. The Lord's Supper is observed every Sunday, not daily, monthly or quarterly.
 - 2. Unleavened bread and fruit of the vine are used, no more and no less.
 - 3. The music in worship is singing, not playing.
- d. Only the church which conforms to the New Testament PATTERN could be the one church Jesus established.
- e. Would you want to be a part of a group or church which violates the New Testament PATTERN in anyway?
