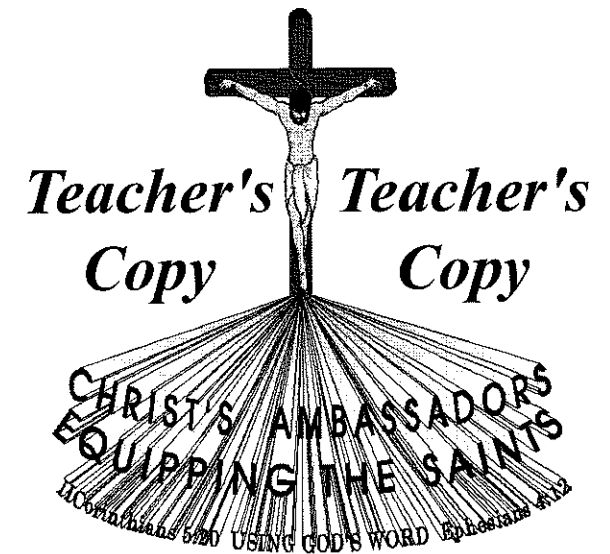

REVIEW OF PREVIOUS LESSONS

- A. Sin causes spiritual death (separation from God).

OBEYING THE GOSPEL

- 1. 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9
a. Jesus will condemn forever those who do not know God and do not obey His gospel.
b. I want to obey the gospel.
2. 1 Corinthians 15:1-4
a. We are saved by the gospel.
b. What is the punishment for those who do not know God and those who do not obey the gospel of Jesus Christ?
c. I want to be saved by the gospel.
d. The gospel preached by the Apostle Paul was that Christ died for our sins, was buried, and was raised from the dead.

- 3. Romans 6:3-6
a. We are buried by baptism into the death of Christ and raised to walk in a new life.
b. How do you get into the death that Christ died for your sins?
c. Will Christ's death benefit you personally if you are not buried into his death?
d. Can you be buried into Christ's death by keeping the Ten Commandments?
e. Can you be buried into Christ's death by asking Him into your heart as your personal Savior?
f. To obey the gospel (death, burial, and resurrection) of Christ I must die to self, be buried by baptism, and rise to walk in newness of life.
4. John 19:32-34
Jesus shed His blood in His death.
5. Revelation 1:5; Ephesians 1:7
a. We can have redemption and forgiveness of our sins (trespasses) only through the blood that Jesus shed in His death.
b. Can you have your sins forgiven without the blood of Jesus?
c. The only way to contact the blood that Jesus shed in His death is to be buried by baptism into His death.
d. If a person has never been baptized, he has never contacted the saving blood of Jesus.
e. Are you SURE or UNSURE that you personally have contacted the blood of Christ in order to be saved (have your sins forgiven)?
f. If a person has never been baptized, he has never obeyed the gospel.
g. If a person has never been baptized, he has never had his sins forgiven.
6. 1 Peter 3:20, 21
a. Is one "saved" at baptism?
b. Does one receive "forgiveness of sins" at baptism?
c. Being "saved" and "forgiveness of sins" both occur at baptism.
d. Can anyone be saved before he has his sins forgiven?

a. Does faith come BEFORE or AFTER hearing the word of Christ?

e. Are infants guilty of sin?
f. Were there any infants in this household?
g. Give two Bible reasons why infants need not and should not be baptized:
(1) They have not sinned. (evil desire)
(2) They do not know what sin is. [QFT3-2]
h. Were the people in this household baptized in the middle of the night?
i. Why didn't they wait for a more convenient time?
8. Acts 8:35-39
good news of Jesus
a. Philip preached good news of Jesus to him.
b. When you preach Jesus to someone, should you also teach about water baptism?
c. When you preach Jesus to someone, should you teach "faith only"?
d. Did this person want to be baptized immediately?
e. Was this man baptized in water?
f. Bible baptism is a burial in water for the forgiveness of sins.
g. Does the water remove the sins?
h. Explain how and why sins are removed in water baptism. (If necessary, study questions QFT 6 3 thru 5 again.) (1 Peter 3:21 baptism saves)
i. Do you believe and accept the Bible teaching on baptism?
